Alltrust Credit Union Scholarship Guidelines/Rules

Eligibility

To be eligible, you must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a current member of Alltrust Credit Union in good standing.
2. Be a 2023 graduating high school senior entering and/or enrolled in the first year of an undergraduate degree program or a vocational/technical program at an accredited college, university, or vocational/technical school.
3. You may obtain a scholarship application from our website, alltrustcu.org, or by stopping into any Alltrust Credit Union branch.
4. You must complete the application in its entirety. Incomplete applications will be disqualified.
5. You must not live in the same household or be an immediate family member of an officer, director, or employee of Alltrust Credit Union.

Scholarship Amount

There will be five (5) scholarships awarded in the amount of \$1,000.00 each.

Selection of recipients:

1. The Credit Union will verify if an applicant meets the qualifications prior to award. Unqualified and incomplete applications will be ineligible.
2. All applications must be postmarked, or hand delivered, to an Alltrust Credit Union branch location by **March 24, 2023**. Any application postmarked or hand delivered after this date will be ineligible. Mail to:

3. Five recipients will be selected from the qualified applications received.
4. Recipients of the scholarships will be notified in writing by May 1, 2023.

Payment of Scholarship

Each scholarship will be awarded to the recipient following the Credit Union receiving a copy of the tuition bill for the first full semester. A check will be made payable to the recipient and the college, university, or vocational/technical school the individual is attending.
